

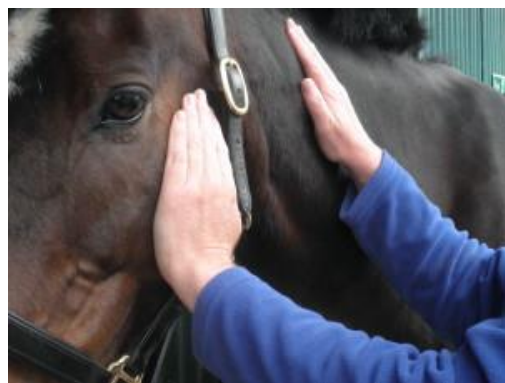


Equine Science & Small Farm Animal Care - Specialty Areas
